I - ASIATIQUE THE RIVERFRONT

A cultural marketplace blending tradition, cuisine, entertainment, and shopping by the river.

2 - TAKSIN BRIDGE

Named after the king who defeated the Burmese and regained independence for Siam, in 1767.

3 - ICONSIAM

Referred to as the 'mother of all malls', ICONSIAM has more than 500 stores for you to explore.

4 - THE OLD CUSTOMS HOUSE

Built in 1888 as a centre for customs and taxation, the building's design is a blend of European and Thai styles.

5 - HOLY ROSARY CHURCH

The church's 18th century Gothic-style architecture are popular with both visitors and locals alike.

6 - TALAD NOI

This historic neighbourhood provides a treat for the senses, with street-art, cool bars and great food.

7 - MEMORIAL BRIDGE (SAPHAN PUT)

Constructed in the 1930s to commemorate the 150th anniversary of the founding of Bangkok.

8 - GUAN YU SHRINE

A sacred place of worship as well as a popular tourist attraction.

9 - SANTA CRUZ CHURCH

Established by Portuguese missionaries in 1770, to serve the growing catholic community, at the riverside.

10 - WAT ARUN (THE TEMPLE OF DAWN)

One of Bangkok's most iconic landmarks and a significant cultural and religious site in Thailand.

II - GRAND PALACE

A symbol of the Thai monarchy and the nation's rich cultural heritage. Home of the Emerald Buddha.
